

Parish Vision Statement



From the Desk of.....Lorella Chavez Sixth Sunday of Easter May 21, 2017

The theme for the Sixth Sunday in Easter is love. Love spreads when we witness to the work of God in our lives, when we praise God for his power, his faithfulness, his intimate presence in our lives and when we respond to criticism with kindness. When we do these things, we keep the command of Jesus, the command to love.

The proclamation of Christ through word begins with the Spirit. This is our starting point. Pray for the Spirit to act in us, then, pray for the Spirit to act in others. Jesus is with us, but not in the same way the Apostles experienced him. They lived with him when he lived on earth. They knew he died. They saw him after he rose again. And they were witnesses to his ascension into heaven. When he was gone, they truly believed Jesus would return in glory. Until Jesus returned, the followers were guided by the Spirit. With the Spirit, they knew Jesus was with them when they shared the Eucharist, and mutual acts of love. The Spirit gives us hope. When times are at their darkest, the Spirit will give us the strength to look ahead. Jesus will return! With the power of the Spirit, our Lord will bring us home to live with God our Father.

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus commanded his followers to love, so they could receive the Spirit and have everlasting life. While we cannot see Jesus directly, he sends a Guide, the Holy Spirit. With help and a goal, we can take heart that we can love, and know that God loves us. For, in Jesus, we see God's love. When we grow closer to others, we grow closer to God. So, love is the means that advances us in the Christian life.




