Here we are, about to close out the Easter season. Pentecost is around the corner. When I was a kid, the end of the Easter season occurred when all the chocolate Easter bunnies and marshmallow pips were eaten. Of course, the concept of the Holy Spirit and His coming to the Apostles was a difficult one for a kid. That this would mark the end of the Easter season was not something that I understood.

Although much of this is still a bit of a mystery, I can certainly understand Christ's message and rejoice as we do in the Psalms; "The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is my life's refuge; of whom should I be afraid?"

This is of course the central message of this week's Gospel. We hear that the Son is one with the Father and the Father is one with the Son. And of course, the most beautiful part of that message; "... just as you gave him authority over all people, so that your son may give eternal life to all you gave him." Absolutely humbling. Not just life, but eternal life. Am I worthy of this? He paid the price for my many sins, and if I believe, I am rewarded with eternal life. Why? Some of it is still a bit of a mystery. But I do believe. And with eternal life as the reward, it is still a mystery to me that some do not.




