To the Parishioners of San Miguel:

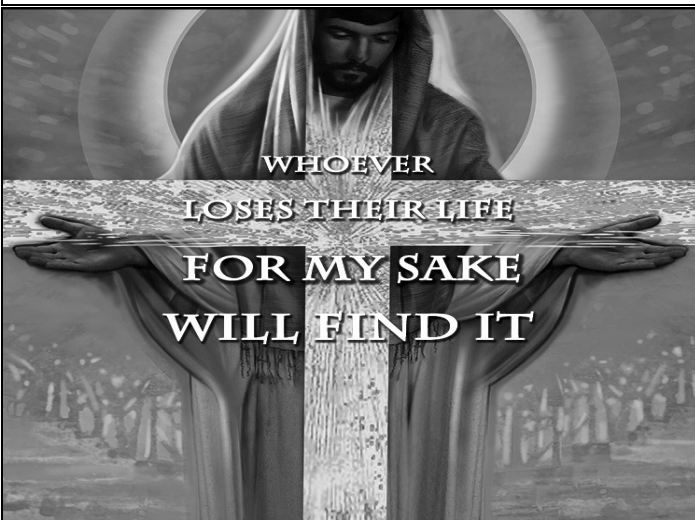

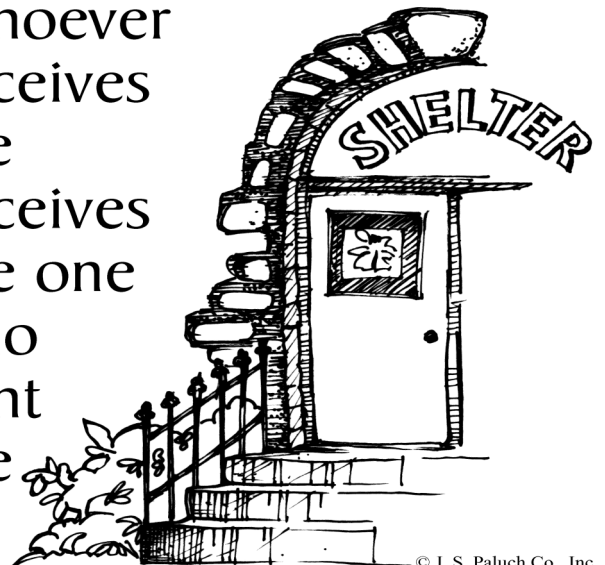
