"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." (Matt 11:29-30)

These words from our Gospel today can be very consoling especially when we are saddened or discouraged by life's events. Jesus knew this in his days on earth and it applies to us as well. Jesus is inviting us to join him and he is promising that we will find rest for ourselves.


Jesus is using the illustration of the yoke in this Gospel. The term yoke is mentioned over 50 times in the Old Testament. In Palestine, oxen yokes were made from wood and were measured and roughed out for two oxen. The yoke was carefully adjusted, so that it would fit well, and not chafe the necks of the animals. Each yoke was tailor made. Jesus said, "My yoke is easy". The word easy in Greek means well fitting.

There is a legend that Jesus made the best yokes in all of Galilee, and from all over the country people came to him to buy the best yokes that skill could make. It may well be that Jesus was using this image as a remembrance of the carpenter's shop in Nazareth where he worked throughout the silent years.

What are the burdens that weigh us down? Could they be financial problems, health issues, relationship problems? Could they be a myriad of problems that challenge us on a daily basis? These human conditions drive us to weariness and despair.

Jesus is inviting us to join his light burden. Any burden which is given in love and carried in love is always light. The love of God and neighbor is our call today and always.


Are you new to Socorro? San Miguel Parish Welcomes You and invites You to visit the Office to Register in the Parish.
