## From the Desk of.....Lorella Chavez Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 23, 2017

Patience, Love and Understanding. I've heard this, at least, three times this week.

What have you prayed for in times of loneliness? How did God answer your prayer?

Whether we care to admit it or not we all deal with varying degrees of loneliness. The profound and complex sadness that comes with the idea of being alone, solitary, or longing for connection can sometimes be debilitating. Worse yet, it seems that with the advent of modern technology and social media we're only getting more lonely. So how do we overcome the nasty emotion?

Faith. We need to remain steadfast throughout our trials and hope in the Lord to act on our behalf. As hard as it is, we need to have an expectant attitude. While we might feel abandoned, we can still call out to the Lord for a timely response. He will hear us.

The idea of battling loneliness often comes down to surrounding yourself with likeminded people, knowing the difference between being alone and lonely, and knowing that loneliness isn't a fact.

There's a variety of other factors that feed into overcoming loneliness but more than anything remember that it's okay to be alone. You can still enjoy experiences all by yourself. Just take the chance. We can be in a room full of people and still feel loneliness and be depressed.

Again, remember, at one time or another, we all experience loneliness. Those times, we yearn for a little friendship, and little understanding, a little patience. The world seems too cold, too indifferent to our plight. If someone, anyone, would just listen, we would feel better.

Pray for those who are lonely or suffer from depression. Take time this week to visit a friend you have not seen in a while. Your presence might be just what this person needs.




