In today's second reading, St. Paul offers his own example as a gift to all whose hearts are open.

The Thessalonians to their credit, accepted the word of God with great joy in the Holy Spirit. St. Paul praises them because they not only turned from idols to faith in the one true God, they also changed their conduct.


