Of Joy and Love

In the first reading, two men have visions telling them to do certain things. Both men respond to God's request.

Thus begins the story of Cornelius, a Roman gentile who prays regularly to God and is generous in his almsgiving. God accepts him and sends an angel who tells him to send for Simeon now called Peter.

Peter has just begun to speak to all gathered when the Holy Spirit falls upon all. Peter makes sure they are all baptized. God rewards Cornelius with the Holy Spirit and holy baptism because God will never be outdone in generosity. God rewards our humble goodness with his great mercy and love.

The psalm today urges us to sing a new song unto the Lord and praise him. Most times when I wake up in the morning, I sit on my bed and make the sign of the cross. Then I begin my humble song of praise, saying "Padre Santo, todo honor y gloria y alabanzas y gracias a Ti por siempre Señor". I thank God for the breath of life and a new day in which to praise His holy name. God accepts whatever heartfelt praise we offer.

The second reading is a beautiful poem by St. John about the love of God.

In the Gospel, Jesus wants us to have joy, His joy. He commands us to love one another.

Let us leave our grumpiness behind and be loving and joyful. This is God's will for us.

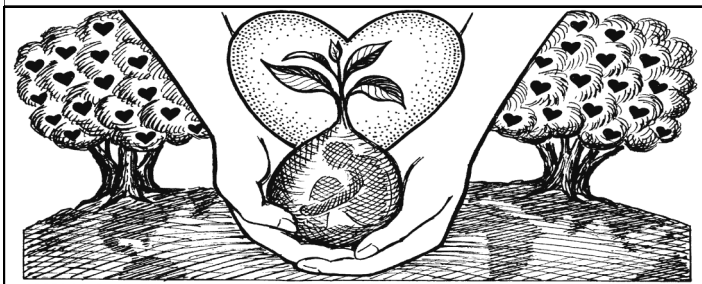

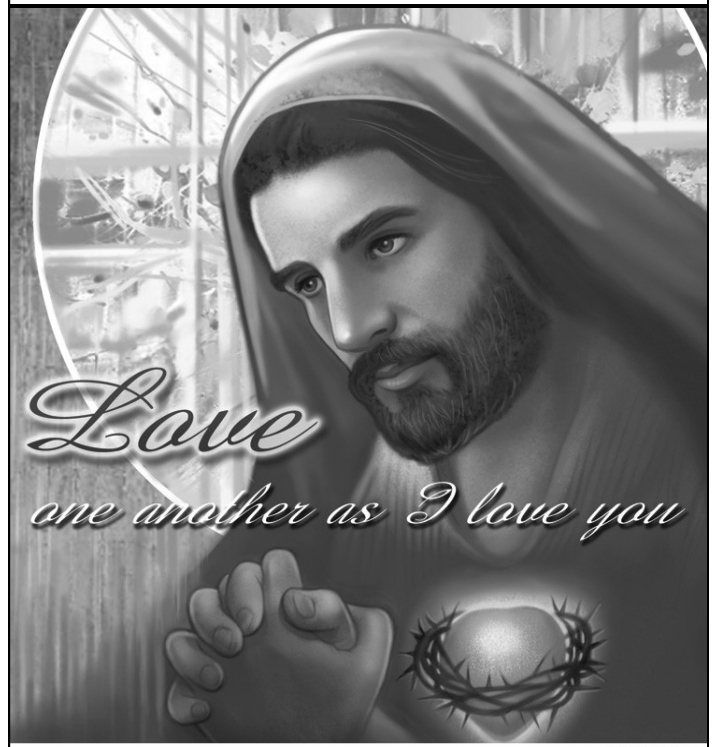

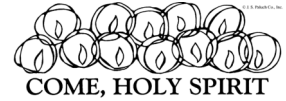
