The Solemnity of Pentecost
May 20, 2018

Pentecost

The word Pentecost is derived from the Greek word that means fiftieth. The catechism tells us that on Pentecost, fifty days after Easter Sunday, "Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit". Pentecost concludes the seven weeks of Easter. However, conclusions often bring about new beginnings and that first Pentecost was the beginning of the Church.

During the ten days between Ascension Thursday and Pentecost, the Apostles were frightened. They secluded themselves in the upper room where they were staying and devoted themselves to prayer. Jesus had promised he would send the Holy Spirit to them, but they did not understand what that was or how it would occur. On Pentecost, they heard a strong wind and saw tongues of fire that rested upon each of them. At that moment the Holy Spirit descended upon them they were transformed – they were no longer meek and frightened, but were bold and courageous. The Apostles received the gifts (supernatural graces) of the Holy Spirit.

Through Baptism we receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit and these gifts are enriched and strengthened in Confirmation. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are: wisdom; understanding; right judgment; courage; knowledge; reverence, and; fear of the Lord. These gifts enable us the to live holy and righteous lives. Throughout our lives these gifts are available to us as long as we are receptive to them.

In addition to the gifts listed above we all receive a special gift (charism) from the Holy Spirit. It is a unique gift to be used to serve others and build up the church. With humility we are called to use this gift for the good of all and not personal gain. Saint Mother Teresa said, "You can do something I cannot do. I can do something you cannot do. Together, let us do something beautiful for God." Each of us must determine what our unique gift is use it for the benefit of all.

Pentecost is not just a historical event. Each day can be Pentecost for us if we are open and receptive to the Holy Spirit. We too can live boldly and courageously for Christ in service to others.

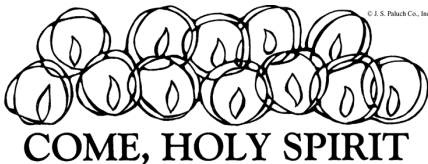
