

# From the Desk of .....Fr. John The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ June 3, 2018

The theme of covenant dominates all our three readings of today. The reading from the book of Exodus describes the ratification of the Sinai covenant between God and Israel. The covenant was sealed with the blood of animals.

Blood is a symbol of life which belongs exclusively to God. The sprinkling of the people with blood symbolizes the fact that God is sharing His life with them. Jesus established a new covenant. Like the old covenant, it too was sealed with blood, except that now it is not the blood of animals but His own blood. By the sacrificial death of Christ, the supreme high priest, God has entered a new covenant with His people.

The Eucharist celebrates this wonderful event, the gift which Jesus made of his life on our behalf. Every time we celebrate the Eucharist, we tell that story again. In the Eucharist, Jesus nourishes us with the bread of life. But it is not meant to be one-way traffic.

Having received from Jesus, we are expected to give something in return, not to Him but to one another. Jesus gives himself to us so that we in our turn may give ourselves to others. As a community, we are in covenant with a God who is always faithful to us. We are invited to live in a way that is consistent with such a relationship. We are not called to be successful but to be faithful to that covenant.


