From the Desk of....... Bernadette Zamora 10th Sunday in Ordinary Time June 10, 2018

Today we are back in ordinary time, and the readings are remind us that we are the family of God. In the first reading we hear about the sin committed by Adam and Eve. Each one has an excuse and blames someone else, Adam blames Eve, Eve blames the snake. They are divided. How many times do we blame someone else when we do something wrong? In today's society, many sins are just accepted as a way of life, but we must remember that we follow God's law. God is the main authority over all mankind, and He offers His just punishment to Adam, Eve and the snake. But within this punishment, He offers a promise to all of us, the promise of the Messiah. He comes to reunite all of God's children.

The second reading is a reminder of God's love; no matter what we do, His love is eternal and He wants us to spend eternity with Him in His home. Paul is suffering, life has not been easy, but he never looses sight of one important fact, death is only the beginning of the journey to eternal life. Sometimes our bodies fail us. It could be due to illnesses such as cancer, or sometimes our bodies just stop working; this is not a punishment from God. Even if our illness will lead to an early death, this is not an end. Paul is giving us a promise of a heavenly dwelling place with God, in a home made by Him, where we will spend eternity in heaven with Him. When we see a loved one suffering, it is difficult to understand and even accept God's will, but God reminds us through the readings today that He is the final authority and loves each one of us. There is nothing to fear because He is carrying us through the pain.

The Gospel today points out that we no longer have to be divided, but can be united through Christ. Christ brings all of us together. We are His family, and as His family, we are offered eternal life. Jesus reminds us that there is only one sin that cannot be forgiven. This means that there is no other sin that cannot be forgiven. We are given the grace of forgiveness through the sacrament of Reconciliation. We can be brought back into His grace because of His great love for us. Remember that if you are separated from God, He is waiting to be reunited with you. Take time to reflect on what separates you from God, come to Him and ask Him for forgiveness. The Sacrament of Reconciliation is an opportunity to experience the healing love of God. He also gives us the grace to live our lives in a way that brings us closer to Him.




