#### From the Desk of.....Robert Aerts Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time June 17, 2018

In our first reading today, the Lord, through the prophet Ezekiel, talks about cutting a branch from a tall cedar, planting it, and then how it would grow and bear fruit and become a majestic cedar. Ezekiel is letting the Israelites know that because they broke the Sinai covenant, the Lord will at a future time restore their destiny by rebuilding the Davidic dynasty.

In our second reading, St. Paul is reminding the Corinthians of their courage and how they would rather leave the earth and go home to the Lord. We are all scheduled to appear before the judgment seat of Christ to receive our recompense according to what we did in the body, whether good or evil. Do you ever stop and think about the moment when you are called? I do, and I hope and pray that I will be ready.


In our Gospel from St. Mark, we hear that the seed planted sprouts, grows, and then yields its fruit. Then comes harvest time. Jesus then compares the kingdom of God to the mustard seed, and how It grows and becomes a large plant, much like Ezekiel's majestic cedar. Thus, the kingdom of God, initiated by Jesus Christ in proclaiming the word, develops quietly and is fully established by him at the last judgment.

Psalm 92, our scheduled Psalm for today's mass, is "A Hymn of Thanksgiving for God's Fidelity," and is comprised of three sections. Section I and part of section III is used in today's Mass. It starts out, "It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praise to your name, Most high.... I urge you to read the entire three sections at home, to find out what happens to the unjust.

Everything we heard today is reminding us of that last judgment, at which time we will be rewarded for what we did, be it good or evil. It's been eleven weeks since Easter, during which time we worked to improve our prayer, fasting, and alms giving. Have we let those go by the wayside and returned to life as usual? Once Lent was over, I eased up on my fasting. After a few days I realized I didn't feel as good as when I was fasting. During Lent, I also discovered the Divine Mercy Chaplet on Relevant Radio. If you want to join, it comes on at 2 PM on 99.8 FM (when it's working), or download the Relevant Radio APP. It's inspiring to hear about miracles that result from God's mercy bestowed during this worldwide prayer time.

Brothers and sisters, let us all remain vigilant, be prepared, for the date or time of our appearance before the Lord is only known to Him.




