Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
July 22, 2018

In our first reading today, from the Prophet Jeremiah, we hear, “Woe to the shepherds who mislead...” Every time the word “Woe” is used by the Lord, He is warning of great sorrow or distress to the addressee. In a way, we are all shepherds of someone, be it our family, our friends, the people we lead at work, and, those we may lead in our Church. The Lord desires that none go missing. It’s our job to see that that doesn’t happen.

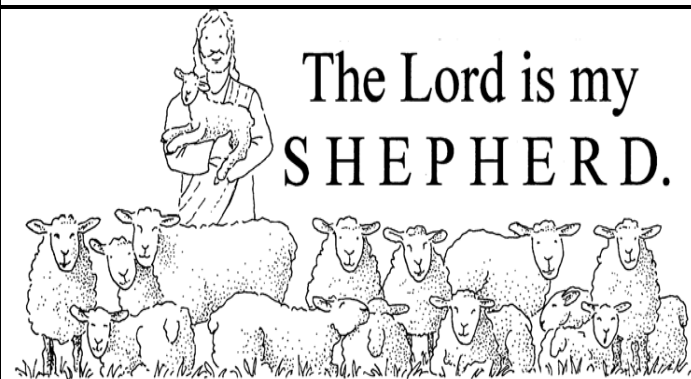
Psalm 23, today’s Responsorial Psalm, is one of my favorite. It reminds me that the Lord is my shepherd. If I follow Him, I will be taken care of. That includes, verdant pastures, restful waters, and more importantly, He refreshes my soul. He’s given us the Sacrament of Reconciliation to use when we need to be refreshed. The Lord guides us on our journey through life, however we often get side tracked and leave the path because of our weakened human nature. Thanks for the Sacrament, getting back on the right path will lead us to dwell in the House of the Lord for eternity.

In our second reading, St. Paul reminds us that Jesus Christ came and preached peace to those far off and those near, so that we have access to the Father. His death and resurrection was to ensure that we had a way to get to the Father.

In our Gospel, the true Shepherd knows what the apostles have been through, having been sent out to spread the Good News. Upon their return, He invites the apostles to go to a deserted place for a short vacation, if you will, to rest a while. The people; who have been without a shepherd, have finally found someone who is giving them sound guidance and aren’t about to let Jesus and the apostles go off without them. They follow, and Jesus, the Good Shepherd, continues teaching them. Later, seeing their hunger, Jesus takes pity on them and He performs a great miracle. With five loaves of bread and two fish, the huge crowd is fed and still there were fragments left over.

Jesus Christ is our true Shepherd. The one we should strive to follow. When we get off the path, hasten to the confessional, and get back on the right path. As followers of Jesus, we must continue to seek our eternal reward, to dwell in the House of the Lord for eternity.

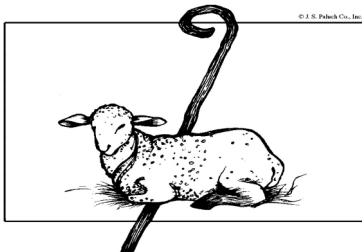
