From the Desk of .....Fr. John  
Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time  
August 5, 2018

In the Gospel of today, Jesus tells his hungry followers that they are only following him because they have enjoyed the food that physically satisfies them; they should work, he says, for the food that endures to eternal life. The one work which earns this food is believing in the one God has sent.

When Jesus points out that it was God, not Moses, who supplied the manna, he compares himself to the God who now gives bread from heaven. Jesus declares that he himself is the bread of life, the bread that came down from heaven. Whoever believes in him will never be hungry.

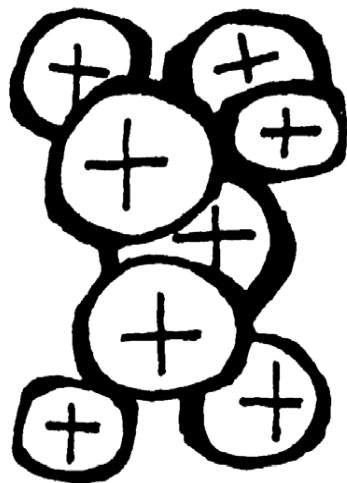
The promise that Jesus held out to the Galileans is one that is held out to us today. It is a promise fulfilled in the Eucharist that we now celebrate. If there is one thing we all share in this assembly, it is the same hunger. We hunger for a love that does not disappoint; we hunger for a world that does not fade away; we hunger for bread that does not fail to satisfy. In this Eucharist the love of a tender God is offered to us in word and sacrament.

In this gathering, we are nourished by God's word and the bread of life. The word spoken is opened up to us. The bread offered is broken for us to share. This is not something we come to look at. Rather it is something we come to do. The Eucharist is a word that flows into deed; it is an action. It is the act of sharing the bread of life, participating in the life of Jesus himself. In coming for the Eucharist, we declare that we cannot fall back on our own resources; we need Jesus, the bread of life, to sustain us. Staying hungry for this bread means that we do indeed long for the food that endures to eternal life.
