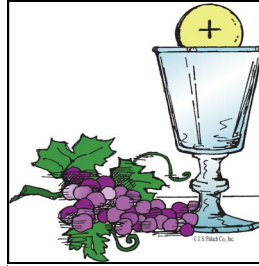

From the Desk of.....Jeff Altig
20th Sunday in Ordinary Time
August 19, 2018

Boy how time flies; tempus fugit! It's already the end of Summer and school is starting again. It has been a long time since I have penned a "From the Desk Of" column. Hopefully I still have something to say.

This week, both the Gospel and the Alleluia, from John's Gospel, reiterate again and again one message; "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever," Christ's offering of eternal salvation. "This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever." Dante, in his poem *The Inferno*, reserves the First Circle of hell for those, who, although virtuous, lived before the institution of the Eucharist; "ancestors who ate and still died". Leaving us with one clear message, how lucky we are to have the Eucharist. In Solzhenitsyn's *The First Circle*, he portrays a part of the Soviet Gulag system that is reserved for those who have sinned against the State, but who are still useful to the State. An eternal damnation in the Gulag system none-the-less. But, because of Christ's love, we are not subjected to eternal damnation. Instead we are offered an eternity in heaven. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life." And, even if we have sinned against heaven we are still offered eternal life; if we take advantage of the Sacrament of Reconciliation and if we accept Christ's offer to eat His flesh and drink His blood. As in our reading from Proverbs; "Forsake foolishness that you may live". All pretty clearly laid out. We only have to do our part.

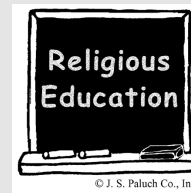
