From the Desk of ..... T. Rios  
Twenty First Sunday in Ordinary Time  
August 26, 2018

Today's readings call for commitments from groups of people. In the first reading Joshua was called to lead the Jewish people to take possession of the Promised Land. Much was going to happen and he needed to know where the people stood. He called everyone together. As they stood in ranks before him, Joshua made his promise to God and the people saying, "As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord". They remembered God's mercy and His generosity and all agreed with Joshua.

The reading from St. Paul describes how a couple makes a commitment to love one out of love and reverence for Christ the Lord.

Our Gospel opens to people reacting to the Bread of Life Teaching of Jesus. Jesus had proclaimed Himself to be the Bread of Life come down from heaven and he offered the gift of His body and blood. The Jews went away unable to believe. Many of Jesus' disciples also walked away saying "this saying is hard". They had not made a commitment to follow Jesus, certainly not for anything "hard".

Next, Jesus turned to the Twelve. He wants to know where they stand for they too had heard his "Bread of Life" Teaching (John 6: 22-36) and all that it meant. Jesus asked the Twelve, "will you also go away"?

Peter answered for the Apostles and us when he said "to whom shall we go"? "You have the words of everlasting life. We believe You are the Holy One of God". Peter chooses Jesus and His holy words of spirit and life.

How about us, where do we stand? For myself, I know Jesus is my "Pan de Vida". To receive Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is a joy and nourishment for my soul. Thanks to our Lord for the holy gift of Himself to us.

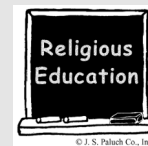

This will be the last class presented for 2018

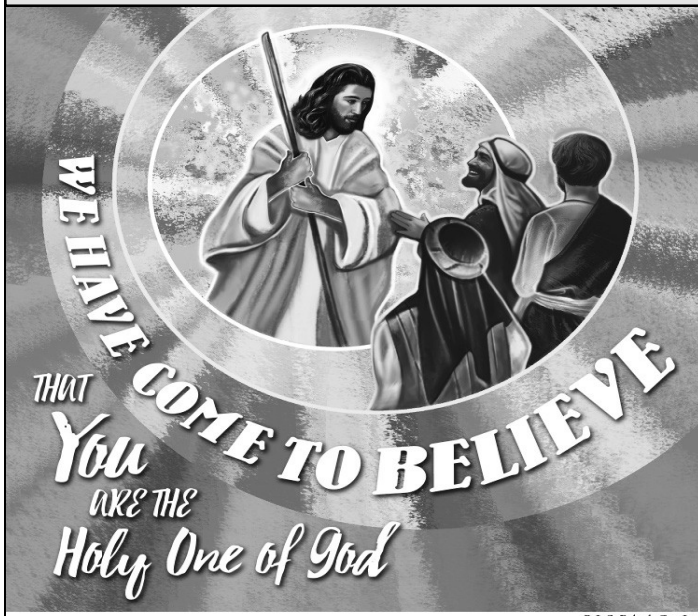
