

From the Desk of......Robert Aerts Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time November 4, 2018

In our first reading from Deuteronomy, Moses is exhorting the Israelites to keep all of the Lord's statutes and commandments to ensure a long life. Not only a long life, but to ensure growth and prosperity in a land flowing with milk and honey. Moses' words then and today are equally important, and those words are "Love the Lord with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength." With all our worldly distractions, it's almost impossible to spend enough time focusing on the Lord. The only way is to turn our gadgets off, and spend some quiet time by ourselves and think about the Lord and the many blessings he has bestowed on us.

The second reading from the Letter to the Hebrews is Good News. We now have an advocate, Jesus, who intercedes for us to the Father. Jesus made the perfect sacrifice in that he died on the Cross for the sins of all mankind. Again, by keeping the Lord's statutes and commandments, our salvation is assured.

In our Gospel from Mark, we hear once again "what is the greatest commandment?" Jesus responds, "the Lord our God is Lord alone and we are to love Him with all our heart, all our soul, all our mind, and all our strength. The second commandment is to love our neighbor as our selves.


Sounds simple enough, doesn't it, two commandments from the ten?

From our catechism, we learned that the first three commandments have to do with God. We are to put God first in our life, respect God's name and holy things, and to take part in the Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. Still easy?

The 4th through the 10th commandments have to do with our neighbor. We are to commit no injustices to any of our neighbors starting with our parents through obedience and respect. Next, is to do no harm to yourself or to others, to show respect for marriage and family life. Next, we are to respect all of creation and what belongs to others. The last three contain the word neighbor, and include telling lies, gossiping, being faithful to family members and friends, and lastly to share what you have and be content and thankful of the many graces God has bestowed on us in the past and for one's yet to come.

Let us grow in our love of God and our neighbor as we embark on the seasons rapidly approaching, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
