


From the Desk of.....Fr. John The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe November 25, 2018

On this great feast, we rejoice in calling Christ our King. We owe him allegiance we would not give to any other power on earth. The apocalyptic vision from the book of Daniel (our first reading) sets the tone. It talks about the coming of 'a son of man', a title for the future redeemer. Basing itself on this same text from Daniel, the book of Revelation (our second reading) looks to Jesus' coming at the end of time, when he will take full possession of His kingdom.

Christ's royal authority comes from his being not only a witness to truth but being the Truth itself. This is why His Kingdom does not seek to increase its wealth but to promote peace, not to expand its border but to establish justice, not to inflate its own image but to lead people to freedom. His kingship he shared with us as we are anointed priest, prophet and king. Sharing the kingship of Christ is glorious but precarious, for it is demanding.

As Christ bore witness to truth, lived by it and died for it, we too, by virtue of the gift of truth received in our hearts at baptism, are called to speak only the truth. The surest way to be lonesome is always to tell the truth. Hence Christ stood alone before Pilate, dirty and beaten, but courageous and confident. He knew that truth crushed to earth will rise again.

We too, stamped with the image of our King and trusting in the armor or our royalty, must witness to truth in love. Witnessing may seem difficult when we are struck by serious sickness, impossible when relationships break down, and elusive when we are flattened by despair. But it is at these hard times that our royal status and strength should shine. Besides, Christ our King who is a tower of strength, is always with us.
