From the Desk of......Robert Aerts 3rd Sunday of Advent December 16, 2018

In today's Holy Gospel, St. Luke writes about the preaching of John the Baptist. After spending time in the desert, the word of the Lord came to him, and he returned to the region of the Jordan. People who are listening to him are intrigued by this new prophet and are eager to hear his words. John is preaching repentance, and the evidence of their repentance will be the good fruits they produce. He uses trees as a metaphor for the people, Lk 3:9b, "Therefore, every tree that does not produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire."

Today's reading starts with a question from those listening to him, "What are we to do?" John's response to the people is, "share what you have with those who don't have what they need." Tax collectors, after asking what they should do, are told that they should be honest, and not to over-tax the people. Even soldiers want to know what they can do, and are told to not extort from the people or to accuse them falsely, and to be satisfied with their wages.


He concludes his preaching by telling his listeners that one mightier than he is coming soon, one whose thongs he is unworthy to loosen. Then he tells them how it will be, "He will baptize with the Holy Spirit and fire. He will gather the wheat into his barn and the chaff will burn in unquenchable fire." Does that sound like judgment day?

Jesus came and preached the very same things.

Christmas will be upon us in the blink of an eye. We still have time for doing good works and sharing some of the many blessings we've been given. What a better time of year for doing just that. There are many people in Socorro and the surrounding areas who could use a helping hand with food, utility bills, a warm coat, or a sweater. 


