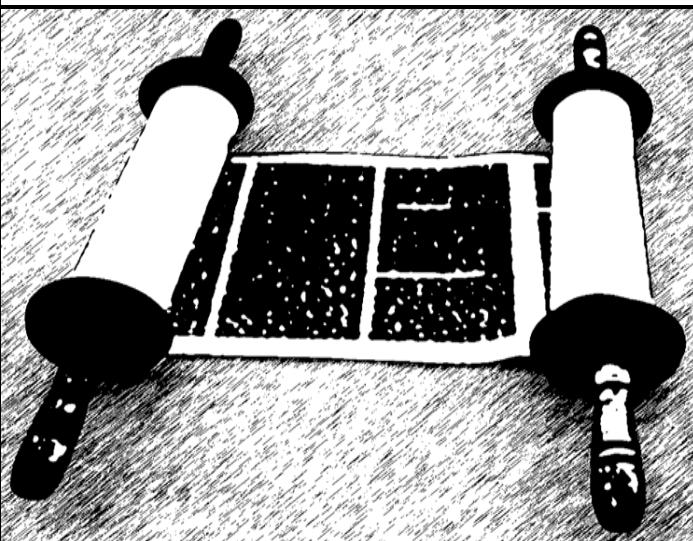
From the desk of..... Deacon Nick Keller

“ I too have decided after investigating everything accurately anew, to write it down in an orderly sequence for you, most excellent Theophilus, so that you may realize the certainty of the teachings you have received.” Luke 1:3-4

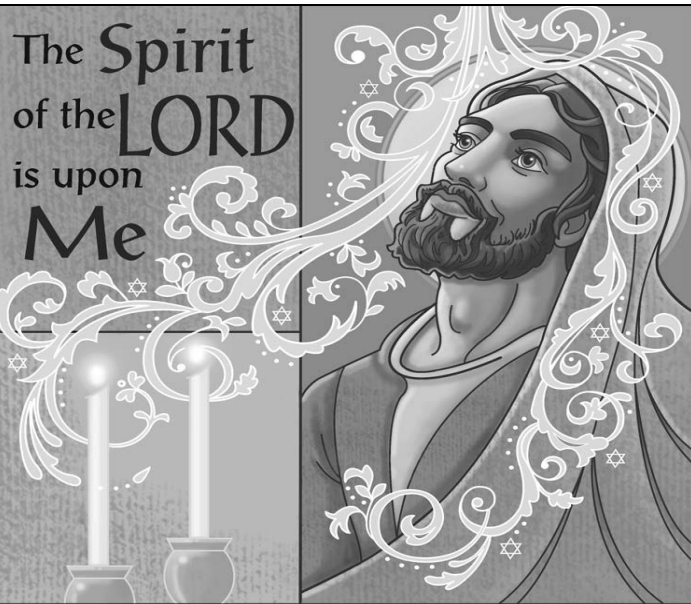

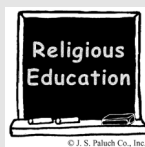

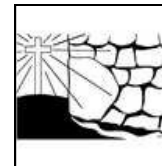

MEMORIAL BRICKS SAN JOSE MISSION @ LUIS LOPEZ

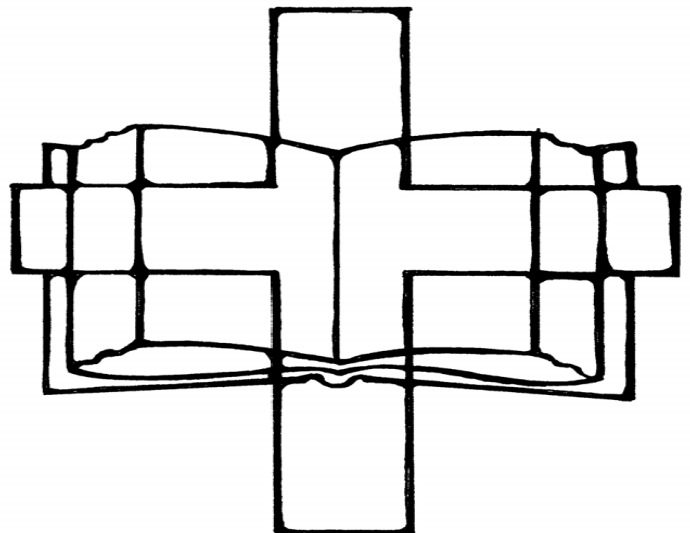
San Jose Mission Church in Luis Lopez is selling memorial bricks in order to raise funds for a heating and cooling system and other repairs at the church.
