

From the Desk of..... Kirstin Keller Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 17, 2019

Dear Sister's and Brother's,

In this week's Gospel, Luke 6:17, 20-26, we are reminded of Jesus' enduring love for all people. Jesus standing on "level ground" emphasizes Luke's sensitivity to the lowly and poor; but is also his way of emphasizing Jesus' ministry to ordinary people in ordinary places-people just like you and me. How awesome is that! As we progress through the Gospel, we hear four of the beatitudes and woes:

"Blessed are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours. Blessed are you who are now hungry, for you will be satisfied. Blessed are you who are now weeping, for you will laugh. Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude and insult you, and denounce your name as evil on account of the Son of Man. " Woe to you who are filled now, for you will be hungry. Woe to you who laugh now, for you will grieve and weep. Woe to you when all speak well of you, for their ancestors treated the false prophets in this way."

This is a wonderful message for all of us. Reminding us that if we are suffering for him, suffering a terrible loss, or having our faith shaken to not give up! The rewards of everlasting life far outweigh the life we have here on earth.

Am I someone who is suffering for faithfulness and will be blessed, or am I someone who has compromised my faith in order to gain some worldly things and will be judged?

A question worth considering.

The bricks are \$100 each for a maximum of three lines with thirteen characters on each line.


