

From the Desk of......Carlos Lucero Second Sunday of Lent March 17, 2019

Hoy, en el Evangelio, Jesús les da a Pedro, Santiago y Juan una visión de su Gloria celestial. Su rostro resplandece y sus vestiduras, deslumbran de blancura. A esto le llamamos Transfiguración. Jesús sabía que iba a rumbo de la muerte en la cruz y que su muerte la sentirían ellos fuertemente. Por esa razón les dio esa visión, para darles fuerza a su fe y darles animo, aun, ven cuando lo arrestaron, torturaron y lo mataron. Ellos contemplan a su Maestro en conversación con Elías y Moisés. Jesús conversa con ellos de su "éxodo" que iba a cumplir en Jerusalén. Habla de la salida o migración de Jesús. Así en la salida quedaran fundidas gloria y muerte, de una manera incomprensible Su "éxodo" se refiere a la libertad del pecado que Jesús va a obtener para nosotros por Su muerte y Su resurrección. Escuchar a Jesús en esta Cuaresma significa introducimos en Su camino y destino, camino de muerte, y destino de gloria.

Segundo, promete que tu ciudadanía es en el cielo y que ¡Tú le perteneces! Y tercero, el Espíritu Santo promete que si fijas tus ojos en Jesús en nuestras oraciones todos los días, empezaras a verlo más claramente, así como los apóstoles lo vieron rápidamente en su transfiguración. Dejaremos al Espíritu Santo que nos ensene el amor y la misericordia de Jesús para que puédanos quedarnos cerca de Él durante el día.

Escoge una de esas promesas hoy, y piensa bien en ella. Repítela una y otra vez. Fijen su corazón en el modo que revela el amor de Dios por nosotros. Porque también recordamos de el poder de la oración, y oramos durante la cuaresma por las problemas del mundo, que son muchas.


