



Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord
April 21, 2019

“Do not abandon yourselves to despair. We are the Easter people and hallelujah is our song.” Saint Pope John Paul II

A young man went to visit a kindly priest. He told the priest that he was interested in becoming Catholic but had several concerns about the Jesus story. The priest asks the young man, “What are your concerns, and perhaps I can help you?” The young man said, “I have read all the Gospels and am wondering about some of the differences in the stories about Christ. For instance, after the death of Jesus there are discrepancies in the description of the resurrection.” The priest said, “Let’s take a look at those.” He pulled out his well-worn Bible and went to the Gospel readings about the first Easter morning. He asked the man, “What problems do you see with these readings?” The young man said, “The messenger at the tomb is different in each of the Gospels.” The priest went to each Easter story and said, “Yes, I know about this. In Mark’s Gospel the messenger in the tomb is a young man in a long white robe (Mark 16:5). In Matthew he is the angel of the Lord (Matthew 28:2). In Luke there are two men in dazzling garments (Luke 24:4). In John there are two angels in white (John 20:11). The young man said, “Do you see what I mean?” The old priest said, “My son, it is true that there are differences, but there is one clear fact in each of these stories. Do you know what that is?” The young man said, “No Father.” The priest said, “No matter what attendant was in the tomb, the basic truth is the tomb was empty, and our Savior Jesus had risen from the dead. That is our Easter message. Jesus has conquered death. Does that help you?” “Yes, Father, that helps me a lot. I guess I couldn’t see the forest for the trees.” The priest said, “Go in peace, and Happy Easter.”

- Creates jobs in recycling industries.


Where to Recycle in Socorro:


