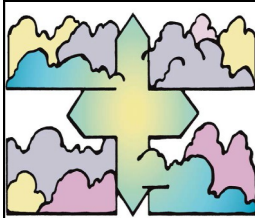

"Divine Mercy Sunday"
April 28, 2019

When as a child, I heard the passage from today's Gospel "Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." I thought "I have not seen and yet I believe", therefore I am blessed. As a child I thought, I had nothing more to do.

As I matured, I realized I did have much more to do. Just as I am responsible to keep my body healthy by eating good food and exercising, I need to nourish and nurture my spiritual life. The Catechism of the Catholic Church states (in paragraph 153) "Faith is a gift of God, a supernatural virtue infused by him." Like all mankind, I have free will. God does not force His grace upon me. It is available to me but I need to be receptive to it. I can accept the gift or not.

As an adult with free will, I can continue to be receptive to the gift of faith or reject it. Or I can be lukewarm in my faith by minimally following the precepts of the church. Or I can nourish and nurture my gift of faith by enabling it to grow and become alive and vibrant. We are all offered these choices. It is our decision.

Every day we are presented with opportunities to nourish our faith. For example: How do we spend our time? Choosing to spend time at the Apologetics Classes has nurtured the faith of many parishioners. Do we make decisions that are centered on God? Do the books we read and the entertainment we chose lead us closer to God or away from him? Do we choose to take time for prayer? Do we try to live the Gospel Message and put the needs of our neighbor above our own? Just as our bodies will die without proper nutrition and exercise so will our faith die without our efforts to keep it strong. It is our responsibility to nurture our physical and spiritual well-being.

Twice in today's Gospel Jesus says to his disciples "Peace be with you." This is not peace as the world knows it, the absence of violence and war. It is the peace of doing the Father's will. By nourishing our faith and doing the will of the Father we can experience this Peace.

Where to Recycle in Socorro:

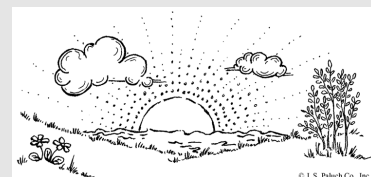
- First Saturday of every month – Newspapers & alumi-

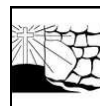
