From the Desk of......Robert Aerts Fifth Sunday of Easter May 19, 2019

In today's Gospel reading from John, Jesus is in the final stages of preparing His disciples for their apostleship after His Ascension to the Father. Jesus has been preparing the Apostles for over thirty days, and issues them a new commandment: "Love one another." They are to love as He has loved.

As Jesus commanded His disciples, so he commands us. It's easy to love our immediate family, our spouses and our sons and daughters. 
MASS ATTIRE!




