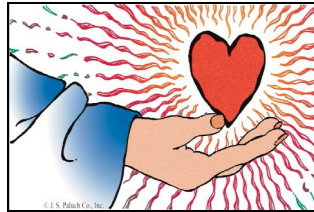

Fifth Sunday of Easter  
May 19, 2019

In today's Gospel reading from John, Jesus is in the final stages of preparing His disciples for their apostleship after His Ascension to the Father. Jesus has been preparing the Apostles for over thirty days, and issues them a new commandment: "Love one another." They are to love as He has loved.

As Jesus commanded His disciples, so he commands us. It's easy to love our immediate family, our spouses and our sons and daughters. Then the breakdown begins, brothers disliking brothers, sisters disliking sisters. Then comes nieces and nephews, aunts and uncles, and on and on. Then there are neighbors who we don't even know, so how can we possibly love them?

Love is an easy word to throw around, but if we examined our individual behaviors, we might have to rethink our standing with the Lord.

Several times over the course of our nearly 61 years of married life, my wife Velma, has included in Valentine or Anniversary cards, *Sonnet #43 by Elizabeth Barrett Browning, (1806-1861) titled, "How do I love Thee?"*

How do I love thee? Let me count the ways.  
I love thee to the depth and breadth and height  
My soul can reach, when feeling out of sight  
For the ends of being an ideal grace.  
I love thee to the level of every day's  
Most quiet need, by sun and candle-light.  
I love thee freely, as men strive for right.  
I love thee purely, as they turn from praise.  
I love thee with the passion put to use  
In my old griefs, and with my childhood's faith.  
I love thee with a love I seemed to lose  
With my lost saints. I love thee with the breath,  
Smiles, tears, of all my life; and, if God choose,  
I shall but love thee better after death.

Five weeks ago Jesus showed what love really is. He died on the cross that we might gain our salvation. What do we have to do to earn our salvation?

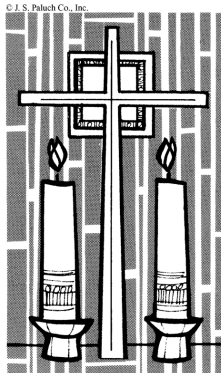

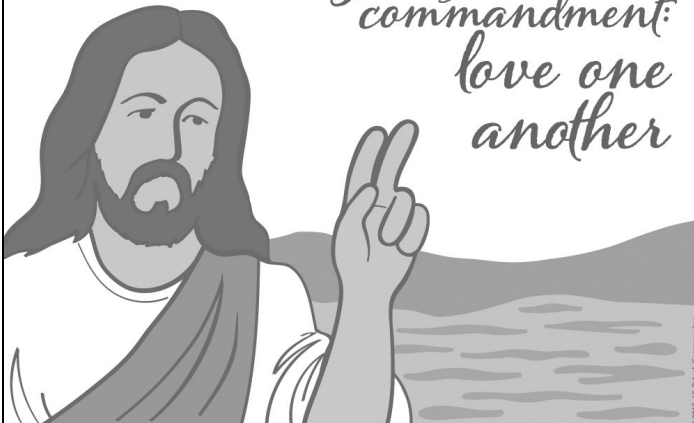

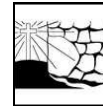

The bricks are \$100 each for a maximum of three lines with thirteen characters on each line.

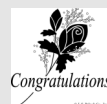
