From the Desk of.....Ann Hook Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity June 16, 2019

There is a beach in a remote area of Brazil known as Trindade which is Portuguese for Trinity. My husband and I went there about twenty years ago. It was difficult to get to and required a hike over fairly rugged ground. We made the effort to visit this beach because our guide told it was the most beautiful beach in Brazil. I wondered about the name. Was there something about this beach that caused someone to call it Trindade?


Our guide was correct it was the most beautiful beach that we had ever seen (and we've been fortunate to see many). It was a small cove. The sea was calm and peaceful. The sand was soft and warm. There were many large smooth boulders. I continued to wonder why it was named Trindade. Was there something about this place that made <u>me</u> think of the Trinity?

A fundamental tenet of Christianity is the belief in the Trinity, three persons in one God. We publicly profess this belief every Sunday at Mass when we recite the Creed. The Catechism of the Catholic Church in paragraph 221 tells us that "... God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange." The Holy Trinity is an eternal relationship of love among the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

In my mind I return to Trindade and reflect upon the Trinity. In this beach I see the earth and sea meet. I think of the beauty of creation. I feel the presence of God. The sea is calm and peaceful. I feel the peace of God, a peace that comes from doing His will. The sand is soft and warm. I feel the warm loving embrace of a compassionate and merciful God. I look and see the large smooth boulders. What made them smooth? I see the power of a stormy sea, waves crashing upon the shore, then up and over these boulders eventually smoothing them. I feel the power of God that molded and shaped the rough rock. I appreciate how He has molded and shaped me. He has challenged me with hardship and difficulty thereby giving me opportunities to grow closer to Him in faith and action. I am grateful. Now I remember the rugged hike to reach this beach and I think of the life of a Christian, living the Gospel message. It is not easy, it is rugged, it is counter-cultural but it leads to everlasting life... it is worth the journey.

Yes, I think there is much about this beautiful beach that warrants the name Trindade.




