

#### From the Desk of.....Carlos Lucero Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time June 30, 2019


En el Evangelio hoy, Jesús está empezando su jornada a Jerusalén. Después de ver llamado a sus discípulos, sanado a enfermos, predicado las buenas nuevas, y exorcistado demonios en Galilea, Jesús determina ir a Jerusalén. Jesús deliberadamente escoge ir por lugares peligrosos y controversiales, ensenando a sus discípulos y también a gente que se encontraba en el camino.

En el camino a Jerusalén llegaron y pararon en el pueblo de Samaria, y Jesús no fue recibido amigablemente. Como los Judíos y los Samaritanos tenían una relación muy antogonistica, desde siglos pasados, no es sorprendente que los Samaritanos no lo recbieran bien. Uno de los hombres que había escogido quería decirle adiós a su familia antes de seguir a Jesús. Y Jesús le dice, "El que empuña el arado y mira hacia atrás, no sirve para el Reino de Dios". ¿Les parece que Jesús no está siendo razonable? Para empeorar las cosas, lo que le responde Jesús a los otros dos que iban ser sus discípulos parecía algo severo, y hasta parecía que eran mal recibidos. ¿Qué Jesús actualmente estaba tratando de desanimar a estas gentes que lo siguieran? Si sospechan que algo más profundo está sucediendo aquí, probablemente estén bien. La hora de su pasión se está acercando.

San Lucas nos está enseñando un nuevo sentido de urgencia en la vida de Jesús en su mensaje. No hay tiempo para cosas secundarias — ni para cosas buenas y importantes. ¡Para esos individuos que Jesús estaba llamando, era par ya o para nunca! Quizás no sabemos que le respondieron a Jesús cuando les llamo que lo siguieran, pero si sabemos los que nuestra respuesta deber ser.

Jesús sabe bien que lo que nos pide es un reto bien duro. El sabe que nos está pidiendo algo demasiado difícil. El sabe también que nos ha dado bastante Gracia para ayudarnos. El ya determino de perdonarnos cuando nos caigamos y de animarnos cuando las cosas se pongan difíciles. Jesús no es uno que da una orden y espera que fallen en lo que pidió. No, El hará todo lo que pueda para ayudarnos.

"Sí, mi Dios, yo te seguiré para donde me dirijas. Y tengo confianza que tu gracia será suficiente para mi."



- In January they wrote that our donation assisted a support group for victims of domestic violence. They tell of Esperanza and her family who were able to free themselves from an abusive situation and now live happily in safety.
