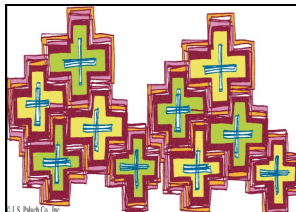

**14<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time**  
**July 7, 2019**

In today's Gospel reading from Luke, Jesus has just appointed 72 others, disciples, to go out in pairs into the rest of the world as known at that time. He instructs them on how they are to conduct themselves, and what they are to carry on their journey.

We also are called to be disciples of Christ. We aren't necessarily sent to go out and be missionaries, but we are called to be living a **Christ like life** with our neighbors, and the people we interact with in our daily activities. Being an example to our family members is a good place to start.

To help us be a good example, we need to have good prayer life, and we need to frequent the sacraments and above all else, obey the Ten Commandments. There is also the opportunity to get involved in one or more of the many ministries available to San Miguel parishioners. There is a need for younger members in all ministries, from Lectors to Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist (both for Masses, and to bring the Eucharist to the home bound) to money counters, plus the many groups that support the Church throughout the year.

In the next few weeks, the big push will be for the San Miguel Fiesta. We will be asked to make donations of goods, time, and purchasing our Fiesta tickets. In other words, doing whatever we can to make this the most successful fiesta ever.

When the disciples returned rejoicing, they told the Lord that even the demons were subject to them because of His' name. In the end, Jesus told them not to rejoice because the spirits were subject to them, but to rejoice because their names were written in heaven.

Whatever we do on earth, having our names written in heaven should be our primary goal in life. We are each given a certain number of days to live, and we know not the day or hour we will be called to give an account of our time on earth.

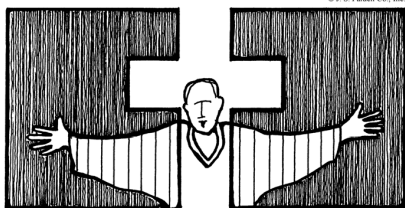

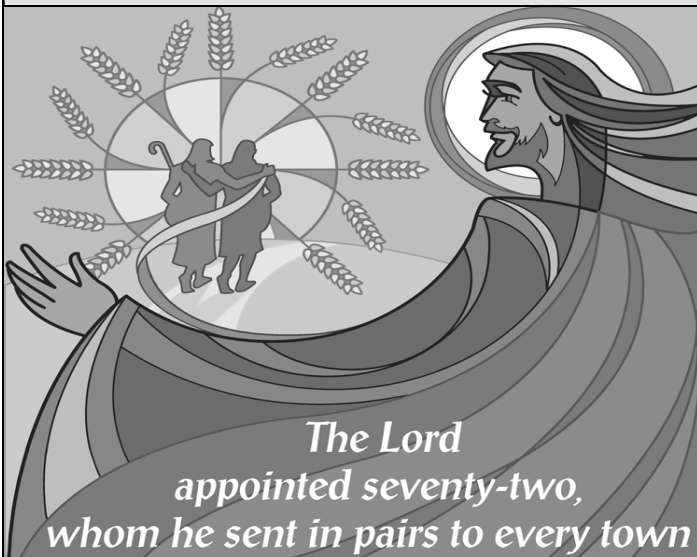
