From the Desk of......Fr. John Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 21, 2019

The first reading and the Gospel of today are hospitality stories. Hospitality was an esteemed virtue in the ancient world. It is still a highly regarded and very necessary virtue today.

In the first reading we see how, when God and two heavenly companions suddenly appeared to Abraham, he reacted with instinctive hospitality and God rewarded his hospitality. This sets the scene for Martha and Mary who welcome Jesus to their home. We see the contrast between Martha's activity and Mary's quiet devotion to the Lord. It is not that what Martha does is unimportant. It is just that Mary has chosen something even more important. Her priority is to listen to the word of Jesus.

The story of Martha and Mary can be seen as a parable in action. Whereas the parable of the Good Samaritan stressed the importance of action, or practical love, in the life of a disciple, the story stresses the importance of contemplation. If we could spend some quiet time with God, our lives would be calmer, less driven by anxiety and worry, deeper and richer. In fact, everything would benefit—our spiritual life, our relationships, even our work. Action and contemplation are not meant to be contrasted. Both are necessary and have to be integrated into life.


