The Piety that makes me a Christian inside and out so that I never preach what I do not live;

The Fortitude to weather the storms and doubts that assail my own spirit and to be a source of strength and courage to my child;

The Fear of you, Lord, that is not terror but awe and reverence in sharing with You in the creation of another human life for time and eternity;

Heavenly Father, help me to deal with my child in the same spirit I want You to deal with me.


