In Scripture there are many instances where we are taught how much God values the virtue of humility. In the book of Sirach, it opens with the line, “my child, conduct your affairs with humility. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are”. If we are humble, we will find favor with God.

I remember when I was a child, a man was talking to my mom and he said, “que humilde la niña, verdad?” I thought to myself, I’m not humilde, he is humilde! I had no idea what humility was, much less that it was a virtue. What a nit wit! But I take what Jesus said, “Learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart”.

When we hear about humility, it throws us off balance because that is not how the world works. To get ahead in life we need to be assertive if not aggressive and avoid humility altogether. But this is the wisdom of the world, not God’s way.

The meal in today’s Gospel was a dinner at the home of a prominent Pharisee. Jesus saw that people were seeking places of honor so that all would know how highly respected they were. Jesus teaches that whoever exalts himself will be humbled and whoever humbles himself will be exalted.

We become humble if, with God’s grace, we try to lead a holy way of life.

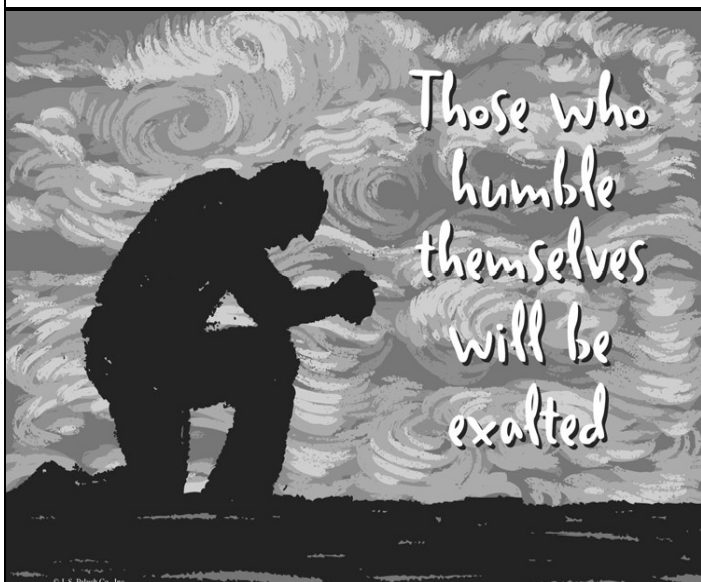

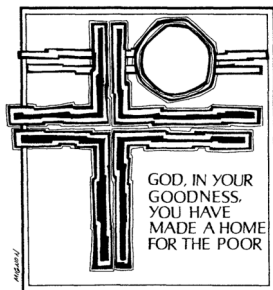

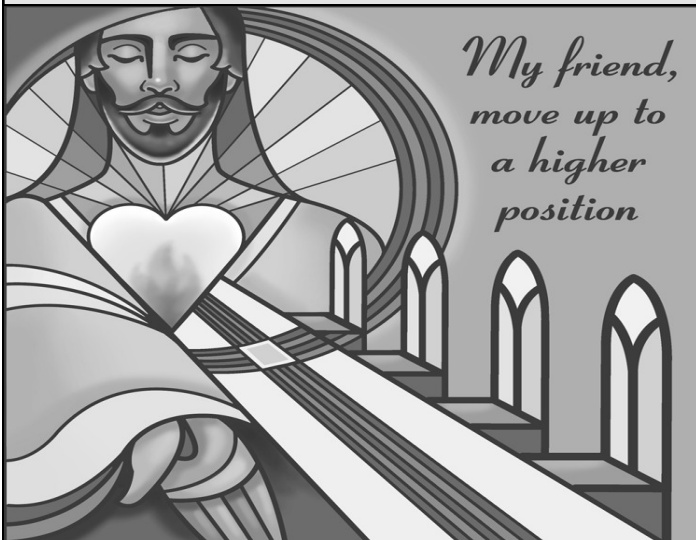
