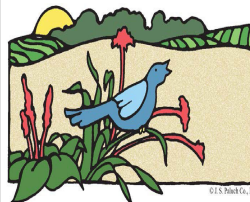

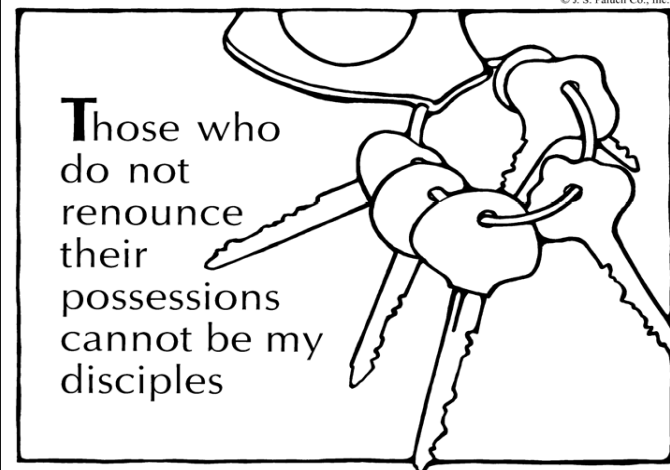

Jesús se detuvo y hablo con ese gentío porque quería conmooverlos un poco u que se olvidaran de cualquier obstáculo que los detenía de seguirlo. Jesús quería que vieran que ser un discípulo era una decisión seria. Tenían que decidir ellos mismos si valía la pena seguirlo. Cristo es el valor absoluto y único en la vida discipular. Si así es, toma ese conocimiento profundo contigo cuando recibas la comunión, y dile a Dios que te lo ponga en tu corazón.
