September 22, 2019

Amos, the author of today's first reading, is referred to as "the Prophet of Justice." He valiantly spoke out against all the injustices being imposed on the poor. Today's reading speaks about merchants "fixing" their scales so as to give less wheat for the same amount of money. This practice would have severely affected the poor.

In Paul's letter to Timothy, Paul asks that supplications, prayers, petitions, and thanksgivings be offered for leaders and those in authority. In today's climate in America, we need to do just that. Offer prayers that leaders and members in our legislative bodies provide solutions to caring for the needy, the poor, the homeless, and the immigrant. Instead of tearing down our country, we need to build it up. I sometimes shudder at what my grandchildren and great grandchildren are going to have to endure.

Today's Gospel from St. Luke has always been a hard one for me to wrap my brain around. Why would the Master commend the dishonest steward instead of punishing him? Jesus was addressing his disciples who were stewards of the household of God, and they needed to be trustworthy in all matters.

Every Gospel message proclaimed from the altar is directed at us, the present-day disciples of Christ. We are the ones charged with trustworthiness. Are we taking care of God's earth? Are we caring for God's poor?

I believe that when we exercise the virtues of prayer, fasting and almsgiving, we fulfill today's messages.

Want to join us in prayer? Very often after the morning mass in the Chapel, we stay and pray the Holy Rosary. It only takes 20 to 25 minutes of your time to say the Rosary. Having done so, will help you have a better day. You can also tune into Relevant Radio, 99.9 FM in Socorro at 6 PM, and pray the Family Rosary Across America. During this Rosary, you can call in and request your special intentions..

As Rev. Thomas J. Donaghy wrote, "When we generously accept God's Word, especially in the Commandments, we are doing God's Will in all things. To live the Will of God is the greatest sacrifice and personal denial."

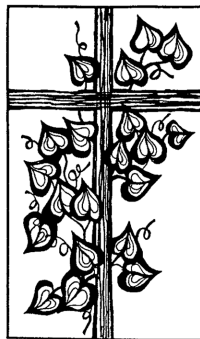
