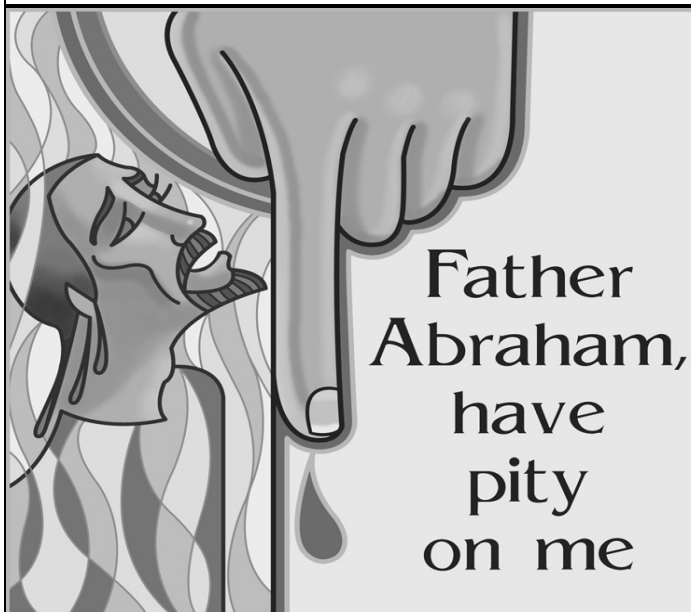
Amos was a prophet of social justice. He spoke to the wealthy of both Judah and Israel, who were unconcerned about what was happening to the country, which was about to be destroyed by the Assyrians. Indeed, by their lifestyle they were undermining the very fabric of the country. And, they had not the lightest concern for the plight of the poor. Amos warned them that they would be the first to be led off into exile.

This is precisely the sin of the rich man in the Gospel. Cushioned by a lavish life-style, he is oblivious to the presence of a poor man at his gate. He was a world ling who did not look beyond the good things of this life.

Today's Gospel is a parable about responsibility of wealth. Some of the harshest words in the Bible are directed at the uncaring rich. Without being asked, and without a thought of tomorrow, wealth is judged, not by the amount that is accumulated but by the amount that is given away. The only wealth that is worth having is the wealth of the heart. To close one's heart is to begin to die, to open it is to begin to live.

As we continue our feast day celebration, we continue to pray for the grace to always be conscious of the needs of one another as we journey back to our creator.

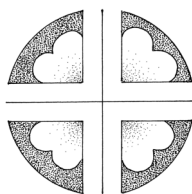

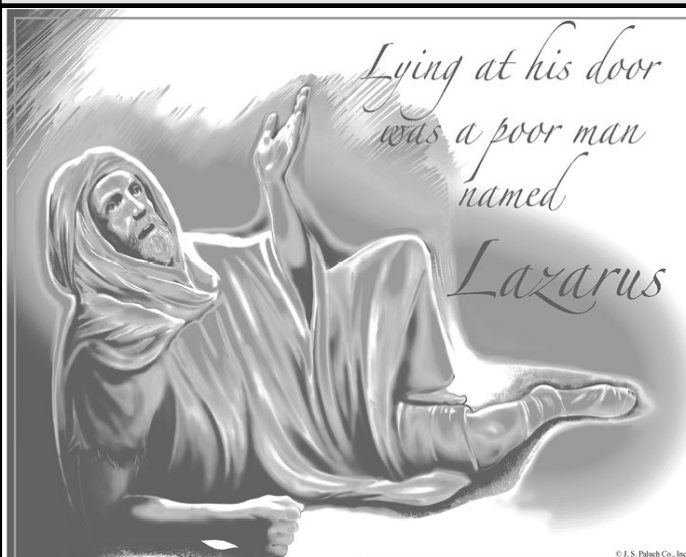
