Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This week's Gospel is the parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector. It is a prime example of the division that we humans can create with our self-righteousness and egotistical behaviors. The Pharisee is immediately convinced that he is a better person than the Tax Collector because of his accomplishments; while the Tax Collector humbly asks for God's mercy and is only judging himself in relation to his commitment to God.

The temptation to divide any people or person into a certain group is all around just bad business. The whole "who's in" and "who's out" game is not for us to play. Our jobs are to be the best people we can be, to love one another, to not pass judgment, oh, and did I say, to Love each other??!

Ultimately this parable has nothing to do with the Pharisee and the Tax collector but is strictly focused on God. Only God can judge the human heart, and only God can justify the ungodly. As Christians, we must remain focused, remembering that it is not our job to decide where others may stand in the grace of God. It can be easily forgotten in our human world as people are constantly telling us otherwise; whether it is in social media, marketing ads, or our friends and family. We need to remember to Pray more and be humbled by the amazement that our God provides, everyday.

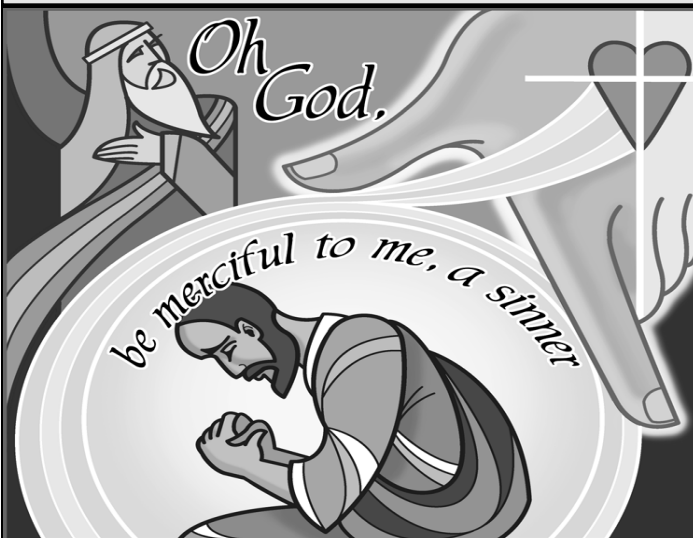
