From the Desk of.....T J Chester Thirty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time November 3, 2019

Today's Gospel reading invites us to reflect on our relationship with God and God's love and mercy in our lives. We are encouraged to know God more each day and to know God's presence with us.

Zacchaeus wants to see Jesus and wants to follow Jesus. Because Zacchaeus is short, he needs to find a way to get higher. He is humble and simple enough to climb a tree! Much to the chagrin of his followers, Jesus invites himself to dine with Zacchaeus, a sinner.


Today we ask if we are as simple and humble as Zacchaeus? Are we so interested in Jesus Christ that we are willing to be a bit foolish in our following of him? And are we willing to risk being misunderstood by others and perhaps even being judged harshly by them?

Sometimes, perhaps, we are like the grumblers in the Gospel and doubt that others are really serving the Lord. Or we have fixed ideas about what makes a person a sinner. Always, Jesus invites us to love every person and never to judge them. Even when the other person may do something that is clearly wrong and even evil, we never know what is making that person do such an act. Instead, we are invited always to presume the best.

Jesus' invitation to follow His way of living is an invitation to change the way that we live. In order to follow Jesus, we must begin by changing our own vision of what life is about. We must recognize that life is about loving others and not about getting our own personal pleasure, joy and happiness. On the other hand, if getting our own pleasure, joy and happiness is our main goal in life, then we have missed the teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus comes to save us and invites us out of our trees to follow Him. That call is just as clear today as it was in the time of Zacchaeus. When we see the homeless, when we see the hungry, when we see the naked, it is our Lord asking us to help Him. These are the people who are Jesus for us today and invite us out of our trees to know the Lord.

We can leave the comfort we have in our tree and climb down the tree to follow the Lord. In this, our God makes us worthy of his calling and powerfully brings to fulfillment every good purpose and every effort of faith. Transform us, O Lord, and draw us down from our trees to walk the path of salvation.

Let us take a few moments today and look honestly at our own lives. Let us renew our commitment to Jesus and to following what he taught us. Let us rejoice in God's love and forgiveness and learn how to love and forgive one another.
