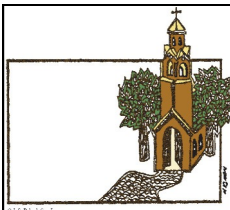

Our first reading is taken from Maccabees which was written in the second century before Christ. Many people at that time in history did not believe in Resurrection although some did, but only for their descendants at the end of ages. Some Jews did not believe even in the possibility of resurrection at all. Maccabees reflects the development of some belief in the after life.

In the story of the seven brothers that the King arrested and tortured to the point of death, they each make clear statements of their belief in resurrection. They put their trust in God, that the King of the world, God, will give them life forever.

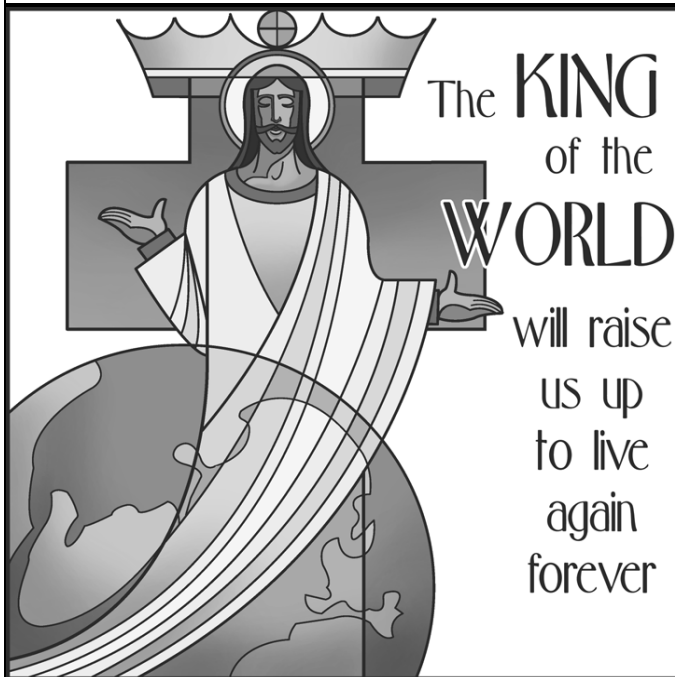

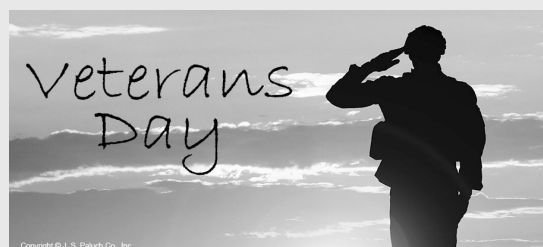
