#### From the Desk of M. Nadine Ulibarri-Keller Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time November 17, 2019

"Lo, the day is coming, blazing like an oven..." Thus begins our first reading of the Thirty-Third Sunday.

I wrote this exact same beginning three years ago for my column then. I talked about how this was an ending time; the end of the Liturgical year as well as a change in the season. I wrote about preparation and how we should conduct ourselves; remembering that our talents and abilities are ours by the gift of God and reminded everyone to love their neighbor. So much has happened in those three years. Many happy and wonderful events, but also some very sad and distressing times. Writing this reflection at this time has given me an unexpected gift.

As I thought back over the three years I came to focus on some more recent events in my life. My family has had a very hard summer and fall. I don't think we've ever had to go through so much sadness in such a short amount of time. Was I prepared for that? The short answer is no. Even though both my faith life and my work life have prepared me in different ways for death, I really wasn't ready.

Is God setting us an impossible task? How are we to face all the terrible things described in today's Gospel if we have a hard time with normal everyday life? I don't think that God said we wouldn't be afraid or sad; that we wouldn't be challenged. In the midst of your personal trouble it is sometimes difficult to think that higher thought, or as I remarked to a friend recently: my head knows that we will be reunited one day; my heart just doesn't know it yet. God promises that "not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

Perseverance... dedication, steadfastness, purpose, grit. Remain dedicated to your faith, hold steady the sight of the "sun of justice with its healing rays", find new purpose for your burdens and face each new day with grit. The "gift"? The support offered by family, friends and community. God bless you all, and thank you for your gift of remembrance and kindness.


