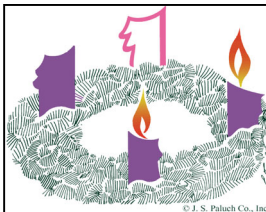

Second Sunday of Advent
December 8, 2019

¿Alguna vez han visto un Árbol de Jesé? Es una tradición antigua que consiste de una escultura, una pintura o una ventana de vidrio de color –como un árbol actual– que describe la gente, profecías, y eventos que se dirigen al nacimiento del Mesías. Jesús usualmente está en su cumbre.

Jesé era el padre del Rey David y antepasado de Jesús, así como las ramas del Árbol Jesé son para mostrar la herencia rica y variada de Jesús. El Árbol nos recuerda que tan fiel era Dios durante el “Adviento largo” cuando su gente esperaba al Mesías. Cada persona y evento representados en el árbol describe parte del plan de Dios para salvar su gente. Profetas como Jeremías y Isaías muchas veces son demostrados. También David, Salomón, y otros reyes, como también mujeres virtuosas como Ruth, Ester, y Susana.

Sin embargo si tu no decoras un Árbol Jesé en tu casa, las ideas que este árbol contiene te ayudan a prepararte para la Navidad. Durante el Adviento, es tradicional revisar de nuevo historias del Antiguo Testamento que prometen la venida del Mesías. Historias de estos antepasados de Jesús ilustran el compromiso de Dios para salvarnos. Es un compromiso que se extiende desde el principio, durante miles de años, y que también llega hasta la Navidad.

El nacimiento de Jesús nos a traído algo nuevo y maravilloso, y el Árbol de Jesé lo ilustra: una salvación que se estrecha mucho más que nosotros podamos imaginarnos.
