#### From the Desk of.....Ann Hook December 29, 2019 The Solemnity of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

Today is the Feast of the Holy Family. The first reading, from the Book of Sirach, provides guidelines to establish peace and harmony within families. The second reading from Saint Paul's Letter to the Colossians provides guidelines not only for peace within families but also within larger communities, parishes, towns, nations, and the world.

The Gospel reading from Matthew relates the Flight into Egypt. Joseph is visited by an angel in a dream and he learns that Herod seeks to kill the Infant Jesus. Herod is driven by greed and pride. He is afraid that Jesus will become more powerful than he. Therefore, Joseph is instructed to take Jesus and Mary and flee to safety in Egypt.

This situation of leadership has not changed throughout history. Although there have been and continue to be good and just leaders, there also have been and continue to be many dictators and leaders who are driven by pride and greed instead of the good of their people. Wars and unrest continue. People continue to flee violence and injustice. They continue to immigrate seeking safety and opportunity.

Wednesday, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the beginning of a New Year. This day is also World Day of Peace, which is celebrated annually on January 1st and is dedicated to universal peace. Saint Pope Paul IV, inspired by the encyclical "Pacem in Terris" of Saint Pope John XXIII, established World Day of Peace in 1967. It is often an occasion on which the pope makes a declaration of social doctrine. This year Pope Francis' message is entitled "*Peace as a journey of hope: dialogue, reconciliation and ecological conversion.*" Pope Francis tells us that with hope we can move towards peace and that "mistrust and fear weaken relationships and increase the risk of violence." He urges us to work for peace with a spirit of reconciliation open to dialogue. He also urges us to continue to care for the environment.

We can celebrate World Day of Peace by prayer, learning, and action. We can pray for peace daily. We can learn about the political and social issues that impact our brothers and sisters throughout the world. We can speak out against and work to alleviate suffering and injustices within our community, our nation, and throughout the world.






Mass Schedule from December 29, 2019 thru February 2, 2020
