

From the Desk of......Kirstin Keller Second Sunday of Ordinary Time January 19, 2020

"Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me." (Jn 1:29-32)

This week's Gospel is very complex, yet at the same time very simple. For example, raise your hand if you consider yourself a humble person. Okay...now seriously, let's all put our hands down! Joking aside, if you truly are a humble person you would never feel worthy enough to raise your hand at all because you would truly believe that you have not yet achieved the measure of true humility.

John shows us his true humility in his acknowledgement that he is before the one true God; he bears witness. Today, a good witness gives an accurate description of the facts. We are consumed with facts and those that can accurately depict them. However, in Jesus' culture a good witness was a person with a good reputation and a good character. John puts his character, reputation, and life at the service of his witness. His humbleness made his witness that much more powerful.

The Lamb of God has two different meanings: A warrior that would destroy evil in the end times (Revelations) and/or an instrument of peace, forgiving transgressions (the Passover sacrifice). The differences in these descriptions of the Lamb of God has become part of tradition. Even today, some see God as the Judge that condemns the World, and others see the Risen Christ as one who forgives the sinners of the World.

What is your view of the Lamb of God? Do you see one version vs. another? Or do you consider both?

As we continue through Ordinary Time for the next 6 weeks let us consider the Gospel readings as we prepare our Hearts for the Season of Lent. Let us take this time of reflection to help us decide how we will become closer to God everyday.
