

From the Desk of.....Bernadette Zamora Third Sunday of Easter April 26, 2020

Today marks the third Sunday of Easter. It is hard to believe because we have not been able to participate fully in the mass for some time now. It is difficult, and I miss not only the Eucharist, but also being together with the community. In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter is telling the story of the crucifixion and death of Jesus. They are gathered together. The Apostles just before this moment were hidden away and afraid. They were devastated by the loss of their leader, the shepherd. They had to witness the horrible events. Just like us now, afraid to leave the house. We are waiting to hear the news that the virus is under control. The apostles experienced the same fear we have now, afraid of an unseen enemy. We must remember that the message of the second reading should comfort us as well as serve as a reminder. "conduct yourselves with reverence during the time of your sojourning" (1 PT 1:17).

The two apostles in the Gospel did not recognize Jesus until he opened their eyes. We are like these two apostles right now, each one of us. We are all affected by the virus that is spreading across the globe. Their hope was gone, the followers of Jesus did not know where to go, or how to go on. The travelers are uplifted by a traveler. They did not know that the traveler was Jesus. We are all in the same position, we have to remember that the same God that brought Jesus back to life, is watching over us. Just like he two apostles are uplifted by the traveler, who they thought was a stranger. Be the traveler to someone you come across. Make it a point to call a friend, make sure your neighbors are doing okay. My niece brought me a mask to wear because I couldn't find one. This act of kindness brought joy to my heart. During this time where we are not able to be present together with our family to take part of the Eucharist, take the opportunity to spread the love of Jesus to those around you. Be the traveler that uplifts those who are having a hard time.






