Fourth Sunday of Easter
May 3, 2020

This week we enter the fourth Sunday of Easter. The Gospel of the Good Shepherd. How much do we all need to hear this Gospel right now, right? It has been a rough 7 weeks and we need to remain calm, strong, and faithful especially in the unprecedented times we are facing.

This Gospel can be a little confusing in part because Jesus refers to himself as two things: The gate and the Shepherd. How can he be two things? Well, he is the gate because he protects his flock, but he also is the shepherd because he opens the gate and allows for his flock to get the nourishment they need to survive.

When Jesus said "My sheep hear my voice" he is referring to his followers. If his followers are approached by a false prophet they ignore what they have to say regardless of their credentials.

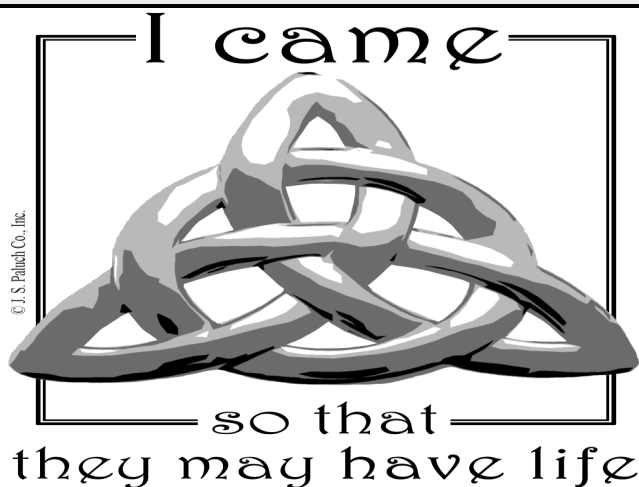

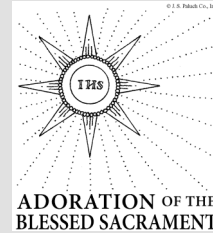

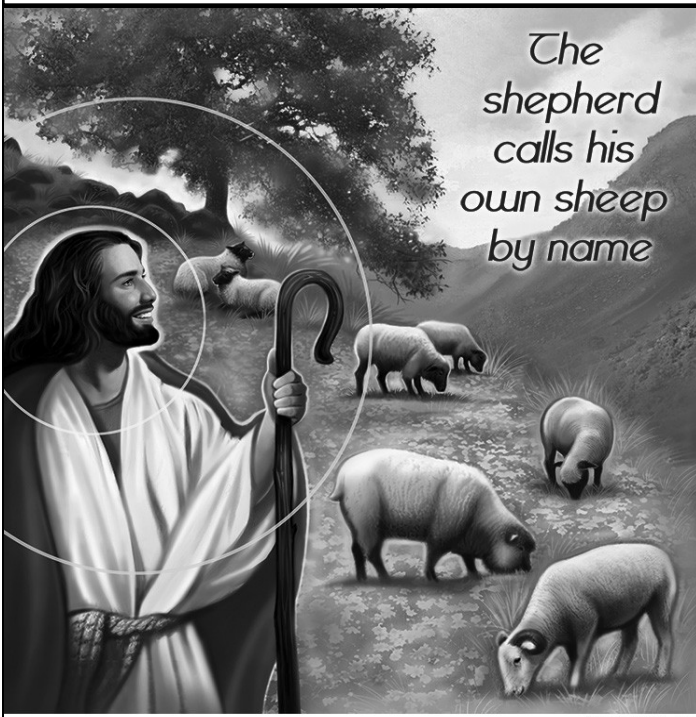
