

From the Desk of.....Robert Aerts The Ascension of the Lord May 24, 2020

Here we are, forty days after Easter, the Holy feasts of the Triduum have gone by as well as the Resurrection of the Lord and Divine Mercy Sunday. I pray that our Churches are now open and that we've had a chance to get back to the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Holy Eucharist. I personally tremendously missed them and kept (keep) praying for the Churches to reopen soon. A sincere thanks to the Churches that were able to livestream the Mass and other prayers daily and/or weekly. Spiritual Communions were central to keeping the Faith alive.


In our first reading from the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles, St. Luke provides a transition from the Gospel he wrote to the Acts of the Apostles. After the Resurrection, Jesus was with His Disciples for forty days, teaching them about the Kingdom of God. They still failed to understand Christ's Divinity. He told them to stay in Jerusalem and in a few days, they would be baptized with the Holy Spirit. With this power, they would be capable of professing Jesus throughout every country, to the ends of the earth. Jesus was then lifted up and taken from their sight. After this, they returned to Jerusalem to the upper room where they had first encountered the Resurrected Jesus, to pray and await the gift promised by Jesus, the Holy Spirit.

Our second reading from St. Paul, is a prayer written to the Ephesians. Reading it carefully, it could be a letter written to each one of us. I invite you to read in your Bible, Ephesians 1:17-23 as if Paul had written this letter to you personally.

In today's Gospel, we hear Matthew's "Commissioning of the Disciples." In Matt: 26:32, at the Last Supper, Jesus speaking to His Disciples, says "but after I have been raised up, I shall go before you to Galilee." In today's reading, they go to the mountain as Jesus had ordered them. He commissions them to make disciples of all nations, baptizing, teaching, and observing all that He had commanded them. He told them that He would be with them always, to the end of the age,

Let us not forget these words, Jesus will be with us always, even now during this Covid-19 pandemic and after it has ended. When pandemic thoughts start to weigh you down, invoke the prayer given to St. Maria Faustina to print on the Divine Mercy Image, "Jesus, I Trust in You!"


