May 31, 2020

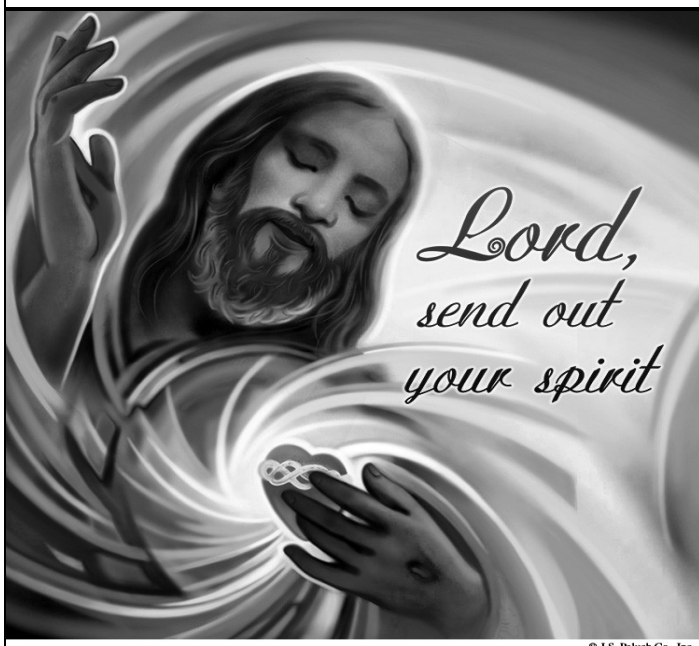
