



From the Desk of...... Bernadette Zamora The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity June 7, 2020


Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of faith and a mystery. God is three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, is a teaching not understood by our minds, but accepted by our hearts. Every mass begins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. At Baptism, we are Baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit; even when we pray, we begin in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. It is a proclamation of love; the love of God for us, and our love for God. The readings today express the love of God for us, his people.

In the first reading, when God stood with Moses on Mount Sinai, Moses cries out to God. The Lord is merciful and gracious. God brought the people out of slavery in Egypt, and even though they complained and sinned against him, he continued to be present with them. Why? It is out of love. His love for the people he created, whom he made his own. He wanted the best for them, and he wants the best for us. He wants to bless us. His great love for us is expressed in the Gospel.

John 3:16 is an extremely popular bible verse. I was flipping through channels on the television one day and a football game was on. I paused and noticed as the camera scanned the spectators someone had a sign that said John 3:16. This is a very wellknown verse, but what does it mean? It is more than just a verse in the bible; but it is the ultimate expression of God's love. He loves us so much that he wants us to be with him in heaven. He created us to love him and be with him for eternity. For this to happen, he had to send his Son. This love is a love like no other, his death on the cross and resurrection gives us eternal life. Jesus is telling us that God wants to save us from sin and death. We have a heavenly home waiting for us, Jesus is the one that can lead us there. That is why he became man, and that is what the Gospel is telling us. The second reading is a guide to how to live our lives according to Jesus teaching.

The second reading tells us that God is with us when we mend our ways and encourage one another. Times are hard now; it is more important than ever to encourage and help one another. Live in peace. This week spend time contemplating the Holy Trinity and the love that God has for you. Allow yourself to feel that love. In the words of Saint Paul in the second reading "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you."
