Parish Vision Statement

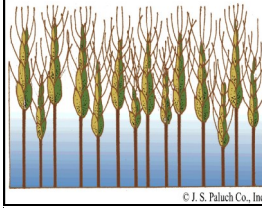

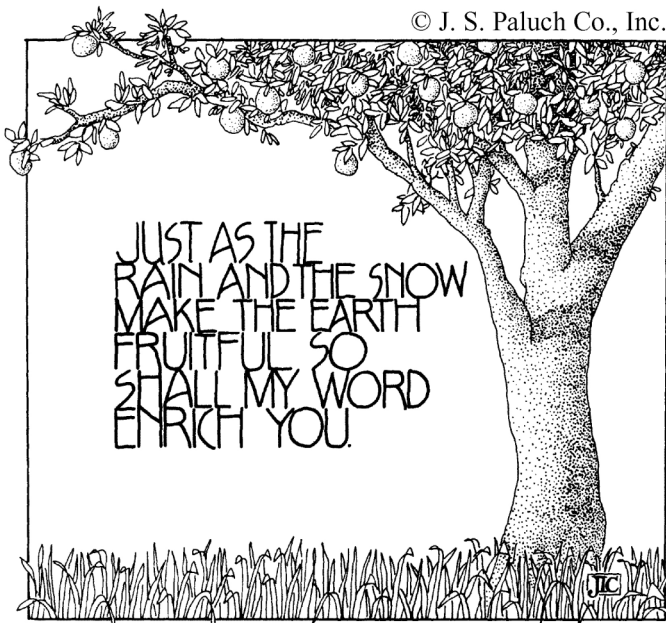
