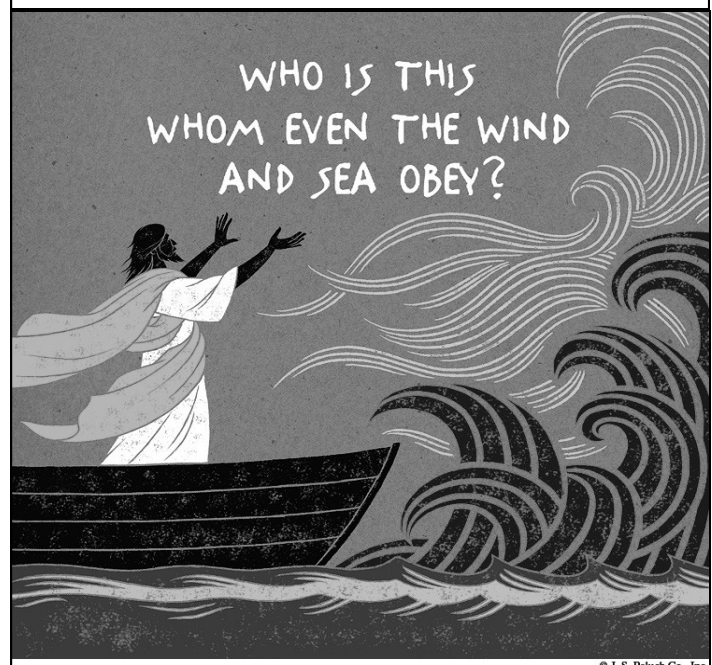
Prayer Time!
