## The Essential Steps of Each Class



Home Preparation— This is personal study that involves reading Scripture and answering a series of questions that will help you understand and think more deeply about what you have read. Some questions will include additional reading from other parts of the Bible or from the Catechism of the Catholic Church to help you consider the passage in light of the bigger picture of salvation history and Catholic teaching.

Small Group Discussion—At class, members of your small group will have an opportunity to share their insights into the Scripture reading. The goal of the small-group discussion is to help participants obtain a richer understanding of the readings and apply them to their lives.

Video Presentation—A video presentation will follow the Small Group Discussion. The video presentation will offer unique insights and profound connections to help you gain a deeper understanding of the Bible and its relationship to the Catholic Faith, with a special emphasis on ways to apply what you have learned to your life.

Review of Responses—The final step—reviewing the responses at the back of this workbook—is done at home prior to beginning the reading for the next session. These responses will help you read the Scripture passages for the next session in the proper context.
