The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity
June 11, 2017

Today on the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, we are called to be a community of love in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. In the first reading, God reveals his very essence to Moses. This story conveys the core truth of our faith. Our God is kind, merciful, loving, and forgiving. In the second reading, St. Paul tells us to encourage one another and live in peace. In this way, we can expect God's own peace to reign in us.

In today's Gospel, the well known passage from St. John (3: 16-18) reminds us all how much God loves us. "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life."


The church's Eucharistic prayer at the heart of every holy mass concludes with praise of God the Father through His Son, Jesus Christ, in unity with the Holy Spirit. This is confirmed by the people's great "Amen".





